POLICY of AB S.A.

concerning waste electrical and electronic equipment

of 17 July 2023

- 1. Waste electrical and electronic equipment within the meaning of the Act of 11 September 2015 on waste electrical and electronic equipment (Journal of Laws 2022 .1622, consolidated text of 2022.08. 02), hereinafter referred to as the "Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act", is equipment whose correct operation depends on the flow of electric current or on the presence of electromagnetic fields, and equipment which can be used for the generation, transmission, or measurement of electric current or electromagnetic fields, which is designed for use at an electric voltage not exceeding 1000 V for alternating current and 1500 V for direct current, which the holder disposes of, intends to dispose of or is obliged to dispose of, which is also waste within the meaning of Article 3(1)(6) of the Waste Act of 14 December 2012, including all components, subassemblies and consumables being part of the equipment at the time of disposal.
- 2. Do not place waste electrical and electronic equipment together with other waste.
- 3. The holder of waste equipment from households within the meaning of the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act (hereinafter referred to as "equipment from households") is obliged to hand it over to a collector of waste equipment or an entity authorised to collect waste equipment.
- 4. AB S.A., fulfilling the information obligations indicated in Article 37(4) of the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act, specifies as follows:
 - a) natural persons, unincorporated entities or legal persons in the supply chain who make equipment available on the market are obliged to collect waste equipment from households free of charge at the point of sale, provided that the waste equipment is of the same type and has fulfilled the same functions as the equipment sold.
 - b) natural persons, unincorporated entities or legal persons in the supply chain who make equipment available on the market by supplying equipment intended for households to buyers shall be obliged to collect waste equipment from households free of charge at the place of supply of that equipment, provided that the waste equipment is of the same type and has fulfilled the same functions as the supplied equipment.
 - c) natural persons, unincorporated entities or legal persons in the supply chain who make equipment available on the market, operating retail units with a sales area, within the meaning of Article 2(19) of the Act of 27 March 2003 on planning and spatial development, of at least 400 m2 dedicated to the sale of equipment intended for households, are obliged to accept used household equipment, none of whose external dimensions exceeds 25 cm, free of charge at the unit or in its immediate vicinity, without the necessity of purchasing new equipment intended for households.
- 5. Natural persons, unincorporated entities or legal persons in the supply chain who make equipment available on the market may refuse to accept waste equipment, as defined in the

Electrical and Electronic Waste Act, which, due to its contamination, poses a risk to the health or life of persons accepting such waste equipment.

- 6. The transfer of incomplete waste equipment and parts thereof is prohibited.
- 7. Waste electrical and electronic equipment can be delivered to, among others, the locations indicated below:

 - notification must be made by e-mail before delivery to recykling@ab.pl
 - the consignment shall bear the description "DISPOSAL/UTYLIZACJA" in a prominent place,
 - the cost of shipping shall be borne by the sending party,
 - only consignments from entities that are exempt from the obligation to keep records of waste and do not issue a Waste Transfer Note (Karta Przekazania Odpadu) are accepted;
